# Worshiping ~ Growing ~ Reaching ~ Caring

Waiting is usually hard. Election day 2024 in the US has not arrived and we already look forward to learning the results.

In Nicaragua missionary Christy Lafferty and the AMOS staff wait for recent governmental communication clarification. Pray for the upcoming AMOS board

meeting in the US seeking to discern God's leading to assist rural communities. We serve as we wait.

In South Sudan and Sudan missionaries Shelvis and Nancy Smith-Mather work with refugees fleeing competing military factions. Pray for church leaders to serve faithfully and effectively as they wait.

In Western Europe missionaries Alethia and Ryan White serve with church leaders trying to meet the immediate needs of displaced families from Ukraine and multiple African countries. Pray for the refugees as they seek a safe home and for the Whites as they serve.

In Gaza, Lebanon, and Israel people wait for conflict cessation. In Haiti and Ukraine some wait for refugee sponsors and for safety in their country. Pray for native clergy in these areas American missionaries cannot visit. Pray for God to bring comfort as they wait and as we walk with them.

In Central and South America multiple people seeking employment migrate to areas of opportunity. Missionaries Carlos and Mayra connect with local church leaders to provide for "people on the move". Pray for Mayra and Carlos encouraging and supporting church leaders in their home countries.

Genesis records Joseph's faithfulness as he experienced periods of waiting. He waited to be removed from the well, waited to get out of jail, and waited for confirmation his brothers were sincere. He trusted God as he waited. Let us Worship, Reach, Grow, and Care as we wait.
